Multiple Sclerosis (MS) is a disease of the central nervous system that causes damage to the coverings that surround nerve fibers in the brain, spinal cord and eye nerves.

MS affects around 400,000 Americans and 2.5 million patients worldwide. Over 200 cases are diagnosed every week.

Symptoms can vary. Some of the common symptoms of MS are visual loss, double vision, numbness, weakness, and coordination problems. These symptoms are very general, therefore neurological assessment and specific diagnostic testing may be necessary to confirm the diagnosis.
